Preventive Drug List Program

All members covered under the CBIZ QHDP will have the ability to obtain certain preventive prescription drugs without having to meet the medical plan deductible. Following are details regarding this program.

Preventive Drug List

- In order to be eligible for this program, your prescription must be a Tier 1 drug.
- Only Tier 1 prescription drugs for the following therapeutic categories may be included in the program:
 - Anti-estrogen (breast cancer prevention)
 - Anti-coagulant (heart attack and stroke prevention)
 - Anti-platelet (stroke prevention)
 - Lipid/Cholesterol Lowering Agents (heart attack and heart disease prevention)
 - Vitamins and Hematinics (anemia treatment)
 - Antihypertensives (blood pressure control)
 - Osteoporosis Therapy
- If you (or a covered dependent) are taking an eligible Tier 1 prescription for any of the categories above, you will be able to receive your medication at no cost, and your medication will not be subject to the medical plan deductible. This applies to medications purchased both at a retail pharmacy or through the UHC/Medco mail order program.
- There is nothing you need to do to sign up for this program. The benefit will automatically be applied if you are obtaining an eligible prescription.
