## Value Based Prescription Drug Program

For the 2011 plan year, members covered under the CBIZ \$1,000 and \$500 deductible plans will have the ability to obtain certain prescription drugs for a reduced copayment. Following are details regarding this program.

## Value Based Prescription Drugs

- This program is available to CBIZ employees, spouses and children who are covered under either the \$1,000 or \$500 deductible plans.
  - If you or any of your covered dependents take prescription medication to treat or prevent certain conditions, you may be eligible for a reduced copayment on specific medications.
- Three specific medical conditions are covered by this program: asthma, coronary artery disease and diabetes.
- During the 2011 plan year, if you (and/or any of your dependents who are covered under the select CBIZ medical plans) take a prescription medication for treatment or prevention of any medical condition noted above, you will automatically be eligible to receive your Tier 1 or Tier 2 medication for a reduced copayment. Additionally, the prescription drug deductible will not apply for these medications (including Tier 3 medications). The copayments will be as follows:

	Retail	Mail Order (90-Day Supply)
Tier 1	\$5 (normally \$10)	\$12.50 (normally \$25)
Tier 2	\$15 (normally \$30)	\$37.50 (normally \$75)
Tier 3	\$50 (no discount)	\$125 (no discount)
